I. Green City Challenge

- 1 Price Hill officially won the Green City Challenge. We had 105 green pledge cards. The next closest neighborhood had 3 (but it was Delhi, which isn't in the city).
- 2 Matt and Jim met with Larry Falkin to discuss how to market our win. Matt has contacted Vice Mayor Crowley's office to get an official announcement event put together. We'll get details to you as soon as we have them.

II. Recycling Bin Challenge Award Money

- 1 Both Community Councils have agreed to hold the prize money until the Eco CAT can write a proposal. We have decided to use this money to advertise our win.
- 2 We are still working on the same advertising ideas
- 3 We are now putting together costs analyses on the various outlets. Once those numbers are together we can decide what fits within our budget.
- 4 We will also be looking to partner up with neighborhood businesses to stretch our advertising budget.
- 5 There will be a 10 minute meeting on Monday to make our decision on where to advertise.

III. Community Gardens

- 1 There was some debate about the number of community gardens that the City has agreed to, but we think it is 15.
- 2 There was concern that these gardens will need a larger amount of liability insurance, which may stop their progress.
